Wednesday 24 June to Sunday 24 July**

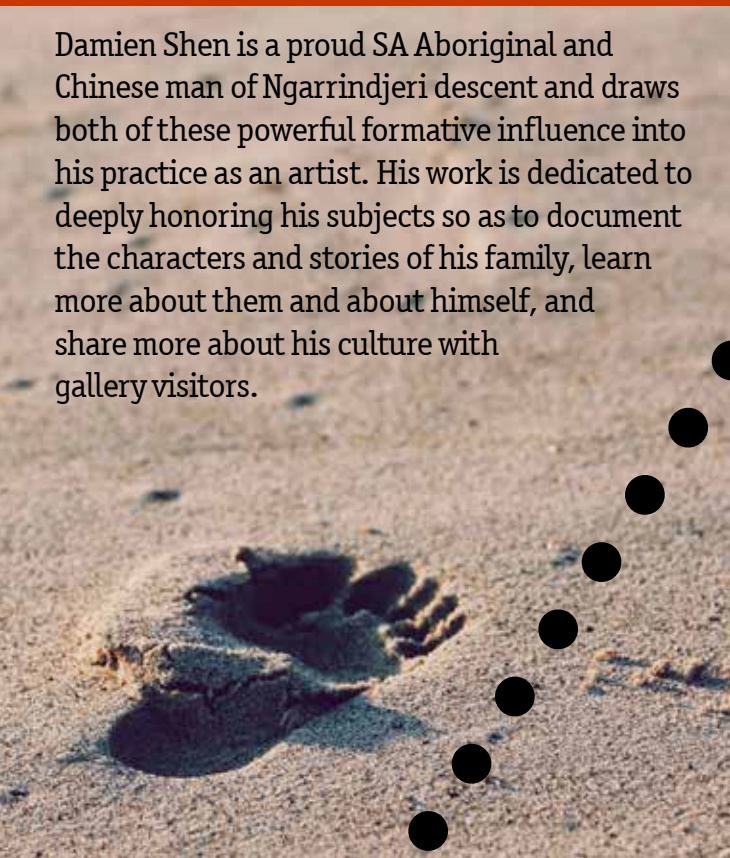
